

Youth Show Rules

Kansas Beef Expo Junior Beef Show

8:00 am - Saturday, December 10th - Breeding Heifer Show

9:00 am - Sunday, December 11th - Market Beef Show

General Rules

Junior Show will be a two day show. Each day animals will have the option to show in one or both rings. A two ring system will be used with a different judge in each A Ring and B Ring. Exhibitors may enter animals in one or both rings.

This will be a prospect show. Steers and Market Heifers must be born on or after Jan. 1, 2011, and Breeding Heifers must be born on or after Jan. 1, '10. Any heifer that has calved will be ineligible to show. Heifers will be shown in two separate divisions - Senior Heifers born in 2010 and Junior Heifers born in 2011. A supreme heifer will be picked from each individual division.

Steers and market heifers will be weighed and classes will be broken by breed and weight. Exhibitors will be responsible for weighing their own animals and turning in a weight at designated time. Division winners will be weighed back after class and the weight must be within 10% of weight turned in by exhibitor. Breeding Heifer classes will be broken by age and breed.

Youth show entries will be allowed in the barn no sooner than 8:00 AM on Thursday, Dec. 8th. Breeding heifers must be on the grounds by 5:00 p.m. on Friday Dec. 9th. Market Animals must be on grounds by 5:00 pm, Saturday, December 10th. Heifer check in will be Friday December 11th from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Youth show cattle may be stalled in the Prairie Pavilion in the designated area. No cattle will be permitted to stall in sale cattle aisles. **NO GROOMING CHUTES OR TACK WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE DESIGNATED CHIPPED CATTLE TIE STALLS.** All tack and grooming chutes must be in designated areas or alley ways.

There will be no showmanship contest.

Exhibitors must meet the age requirements of their respective Junior Breed Associations. Exhibitors cannot have reached their 21st birthday prior to January 1, 2011. Exhibitors must show their own animal unless they have more than one animal in a single class or have special circumstances previously approved by show committee.

The Kansas Beef Expo Executive Committee will have final ruling on interpretation of all rules.

Breed must have at least three head to represent a breed division. If fewer than three are entered, that breed will show as AOB. Exceptions exist if award is sponsored by breed association or sponsor.

Each steer showing in a breed specific class may be subject to a screening committee. All screening committee decisions are final.

All heifers must be registered in the name of the junior exhibitor. In the instance of multiple registration, junior exhibitor name must be present on registration papers. Registration papers must be presented at the show. Heifers entering the AOB class must be registered heifers (not commercial). There will be a commercial heifer class offered.

All heifers purchased at the 2010 or 2011 Snow Angels sale are eligible to show in the Beef Expo Youth Show, the entry fee will be waived on these animals.

All animals are required to have an official health certificate issued within 30 days of the show. Animals with lesions of ringworm, warts or infested with mange will be excused from the premises.

Breed Steer Eligibility

Angus

Steers must have American Angus Association registration papers and corresponding tattoo. Steers must show typical Angus type as determined by the Classification Committee. The decision of the Classification Committee is final.

Charolais

Steers must be at least 50% Charolais or higher, show Charolais characteristics, and be out of a registered Charolais sire or dam. Steer exhibitors must provide a Kansas Charolais Association steer certificate or an AICA certificate.

Chianina

Steers must meet registration requirements as defined by the American Chianina Association, be registered with ACA and have a legible tattoo corresponding to the registration papers.

Gelbvieh

Steers must be 3/8 Gelbvieh or greater and be accompanied by an official aphidavid from the AGA or State Association.

Hereford and Polled Hereford

Steers must be out of a registered or purebred cow. They must have a Hereford steer certificate obtained from the American Hereford Association or a Kansas Polled Hereford Association steer certificate.

Limousin

Steers must be 50% or higher, sired by a registered Limousin bull or out of a registered Limousin cow. Steers need not be registered, but exhibitors must provide a completed State Association Steer Certificate. A completed KLBA steer certificate may be obtained from the breeder or the Kansas Limousin Assn.

Maine-Anjou

Steers must be 1/4 or higher Maine-Anjou, sired by a Maine-Anjou bull, registered with the American Maine-Anjou Association and have a legible tattoo corresponding to the registration papers.

Red Angus

Steer must be category 1a or 1b with American Red Angus Association registration papers and corresponding tattoo.

Shorthorn

Steers must be 15/16 or higher and have a Kansas Shorthorn Association verification form or American Shorthorn Association purebred registration certificate (red color form).

Appendix Shorthorn

Steers must be 7/8 or less and have a Kansas Shorthorn Association verification form or American Shorthorn Association purebred registration certificate (green color form).

Simmental

Steers must be at least 50% Simmental, accompanied by an American Simmental Association performance pedigree and have legible tattoos corresponding to the accompanying performance pedigree.

AOB

Class is for all breed qualified steers that do not have minimum numbers for breed division or breed steers that do not have a division. All AOB steers must have association certificates and or possess breed characteristics to be qualified as a breed steer.

Crossbred

All steers that do not classify in above listed divisions, do not possess breed characteristics associate with specific breed, crossbred steers and or any steer not deemed fit to be represented by a specific breed. All breed listed above are potential breed divisions, all breeds must have a minimum of three entries to be enstated as a breed division. Show committee has right to add or delete divisions based on number of head participating.
